




Milling for Home Machinists (Paperback)

The reader advances through a series of practice projects that teach how to use the milling machine and develop essential skills through practical application. This book takes beginners through all of the basic techniques needed to tackle a wide range of machining operations. A getting started section reviews the necessary tools and equipment. Four minor and four major milling projects are provided that provide the opportunity to gain basic skills, and then use that expertise to build a series of useful and increasingly complex tools. Each project is designed to develop essential milling machine skills that the reader will use again and again in the future. The eight projects are extensively illustrated, with full workshop drawings accompanying the text.
