Male victims of domestic violence are not only victimized by abusive women but also by a justice system that refuses to protect men from violent women. Local law enforcement agencies do not take action to deter female to male domestic violence even when allegations of abuse are reported and clearly documented in police reports. For decades, law enforcement agencies have not been properly trained to identify female batterers or false reporters, largely because of political considerations. Therefore, responding officers rarely question women s statements during a report because they lack training and fall back on faulty gender stereotypes. In most cases, female batterers count on gender stereotypes when making a false allegation. Using the harmful myth of men are abusers and women are victims in domestic violence situations gives female batterers even more power and control over their male victims. However, when men report abuse they will often receive no sympathy or protection from their batterer. Abused men, more often...
