This biography proves how a person whom experts had given up as being a hopeless case, and who would normally have been confined to sheltered accommodation and work, is nevertheless capable of leading an independent life. In 2003, the 'International Institute for Advanced Studies in Systems Research and Cybernetics' has awarded Wilfried Kriese the degree of 'Dr. h. c.' (Doctor honoris causa). In the German-speaking area as well as probably the whole of Europe, it is unique for a person with a background like Wilfried Kriese to be awarded such an honor 128 pp. Englisch.
